The US Visa Waiver Programme (VWP) allows most British Citizen passport holders to visit the US for up to 90 days for general travel/tourism.

If travelling under the VWP you should provide details online 72 hours prior to travel. This is currently voluntary but it is expected to become compulsory for all travellers from 12 January 2009.
