Sleep A former 18th-century sugar-mill estate, Jalousie Plantation at Sugar Beach, on St Lucia's south-west coast, has had a makeover. The new villas are jaw-droppingly luxurious. Colonial-style ceiling fans, four-posters and all-white furnishings exude old-world charm, while flatscreen televisions and plunge pools are sure to satisfy modern sybarites.

Eat Enjoy views of the Piton peaks and the ocean while tucking into traditional gourmet Caribbean cuisine, such as roast conch with pickled vegetables, at Dasheene, Ladera resort's open-sided restaurant, set in the hills above Jalousie Plantation.

Don't miss Hiking up the volcanic Piton peaks and bathing in the sulphur-rich springs in nearby Qualibou caldera.
